SUBMISSIONS AND HEARINGS

The Select Committee on Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs (Youth, Women & IGR) invites stakeholders and interested persons to submit written submissions on Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Amendment Bill

The purpose of the Traditional Leadership Governance Framework Amendment Bill is to:

- To amend the Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Act, 2003, so as to make provision for extended timeframes within which kingship and queenship councils and traditional councils must be established;
- To provide for extended timeframes within which community authorities have to be disestablished:
- To align the term of office of tribal authorities, traditional councils and kingship or queenship councils with the term of the National House of Traditional Leaders; and
- To provide for matters connected therewith.

Submissions must be received by no later than 27 October 2017.
